The Extremes to Avoid:

Extreme 1: Contradicts God's authority by allowing women authoritative roles over men.

Extreme 2: Misinterprets silence as absolute, contradicting Paul's teachings.

Goal: Seek the biblical balance between these two unbiblical positions.

Defining Prohibitions

Prohibited: Women in authoritative roles over men in the church assembly.

The women are to keep <u>silent</u> in the churches; for they are <u>not permitted to speak</u>, but are to subject themselves, just as the Law also says. ³⁵ If they desire to learn anything, let them ask their own husbands at home; for it is improper for a woman to speak in church. –1 Corinthians 14:34-35

Silent – Gk. Sigato: complete silence, to stop speaking altogether

Defining Prohibitions

Prohibited: Women in authoritative roles over men in the church assembly.

¹¹ A woman must <u>quietly receive instruction with entire</u> <u>submissiveness</u>. ¹² But I do not allow a woman to teach or exercise authority over a man, but to remain <u>quiet</u>.

-1 Timothy 2:11-12

Silence / Quietly – Gk. Hesuchia: quietness / restfulness

- not absolute prohibition on speech.

Defining Prohibitions

Prohibited: Women in authoritative roles over men in the church assembly.

Context: Prohibition specific to the assembly of the church for worship and/or teaching:

- Assembly <u>Preaching</u> / Teaching (1 Tim 2:11-12)
- Serving as <u>Deacons</u> (1 Tim.3:8, "men of dignity")
- Serving as <u>Elders</u> (1 Tim. 3:2, "husband of one wife")
 - Leading in any <u>authoritative role</u> over a man within the context of the church.

What is Permitted?

Permitted Participation:

- Singing/Harmonizing
- Informal Ministry Settings (woman's studies, children's classes, evangelism, older women mentoring younger, hospitality, acts of service)
- Audible Amens Affirming Truth / Prayer
- Bible Class Scripture Reading / Q&A

What is Permitted?

Context: 1 Corinthians 11:5 - participation under male leadership, but <u>not absolute silence</u>.

Evidence: Prophesying by women permitted through direct operation of the H.S. (*first century*), but still under the authority of male leadership.

• 1 Cor. 11:5 is used to harmonize scripture regarding the use of "silence" for women in the church –does not serve as an authorized directive for the church today.

What is Permitted?

Evidence:

- Repeated commands to sing (Eph. 5:19, Col. 3:16)
 involves speaking and teaching through lyrics.
- <u>Laboring for the gospel</u> (Acts 18:26, Rom. 16)
 properly done under male oversight as the early
 church upheld scriptural roles.

Upholding God's Wisdom

Reasons for Role Distinctions:

- 1. They model the principle of headship as God designed (1 Cor 11:3, 1 Timothy 2:11-12)
- 2. Upholds God's created design (1 Tim 2:13, Gen 2:18)

The Call to Obedience

Reject cultural protests against God's roles

God expects obedience in the home and the church
