Surrender

HEBREWS 5:1-10

Hebrews 5:1-10

Surrender:

- High priests are chosen among people to offer sacrifices for sins (v. 1-3)
- Only God appoints high priests, a role exemplified by Aaron (v. 4)
- Jesus, appointed by God, did not exalt himself to high priesthood (v. 5)
- Declared a priest forever, Jesus fulfills the order of Melchizedek (v. 6)
- Through prayers and suffering, Jesus learned obedience (v. 7-8)
- His obedience made him the source of eternal salvation (v. 9-10)

Implications:

- We are represented by Christ, our perfect high priest.
- We are called by God, our loving and faithful Father.
- We are saved by Christ, our obedient and suffering Savior.
